## **WHO WE ARE...**

We are sold out for Jesus, and looking for others who are to come alongside our students as they Know Jesus further, Grow in Community, and Go to their street corners.



## **WHAT WE ARE LOOKING FOR...**

We are looking for people interested in Walking with the next generation of believers. We have an amazing group of students that we are looking for people to show them Jesus.



## **WHATS THE COMMITMENT...**

We ask for a minimum of a year commitment, but are looking for people who have the potential to walk many years with our students. (It is not uncommon for our leaders to stay with a group for 3-7 years, and we love this). Its commitment is Sunday Evenings During the Fall and Winter Semesters.



# MEETINGS

## LARGE GROUP

These times are biweekly on Sundays from 6:15-8:15pm. With a leader meeting from 5-6 on these Sundays The purpose is for students to gather and grow in a diverse community together. We gather together to seek God and be changed by Him. Evenings include a variety of activities including... prayer, scripture, teaching, guest speakers, games, family meals, outreach, service, worship, but are never the same. These usually are set up in such a way where leaders can come and just be present with the student. Any details will be communicated at the leader meeting, but the intent is that things are structured in a way where you can be present with your students without worrying about details.

## SMALL GROUPS

These are the nights that you as leaders get to create, plan, and make disciples. Small groups also happen biweekly Sundays from 6:15-8:15pm rotating with large group. Small group is a smaller setting that allows us to dive in relationally. Jesus modeled for us times in large groups and times in smaller groups. It is at this time that we want you to disciple our students. We ask that you commit to being at every small group, as there are only two per month. The main elements at small groups are prayer, scripture and fellowship. We ask that you come prepared to discuss that week's sermon, and also that you would pray together. However, we also ask that as you get to know your students you would, in collaboration with Max, work to encourage and challenge your students in whichever areas of discipleship are needed.

## TRAININGS

Throughout the year we have occasional trainings, but our desire is to recruit leaders who are in love with Jesus and are ready to make disciples. This does not mean that you must have every answer, nobody does, but that you are Walking with Jesus and ready to share your walk.
